# **About Descriptions** of "Estimated Inundation"


Flood disasters in recent years are frequently caused by localized torrential downpour, etc. and there has been an increasing number of cases where rivers have risen or breached their banks, causing extensive damage. To minimize the damage caused by flood, it is important to recognize the risks of flood disasters at ordinary times and to be aware of accurate information about areas at risk of flooding and evacuation sites.


In this Disaster Prevention Guide Hazard Map, areas where inundation is expected and expected water levels are indicated on the map, if a river overflows due to the largest scale rainfall expectable (estimated maximum).

However, this simulation does not include the flooding of river branches or of landside water, which suggests the possibility of inundation occurring in areas other than these inundation-estimated areas. Also, the estimated water level may be different from the actual inundation height.

Since it is only a simulation, it is best to utilize it as a guide for countermeasures for flood damage, such as for evacuation, etc.

\* This Estimated Inundation Area Map describes inundation height and other information expected to be observed when the concerned area is inundated by the largest scale rainfall expectable, based on the estimated inundation area map and flood risk information map for Karasu River, Kanna River, Kabura River, Usui River, Koyama River, Fuku River, and Onnabori River, published by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism and Saitama Prefecture.
